Golf season is in full swing. At least 50% of our Scotch teams have been eliminated (Tom Mesch always says that frees up his summer or his golf season is over). Tradition

Matches have begun, and of course our gem of a golf course is in full bloom.

I want to share a few facts with you as I write this letter.

The Facilities Committee is hard at work creating a priority list or master plan for all of our buildings. As they complete this very important task, they have already recommended and the Board has approved, two projects for this spring. First, the pump house by 18 tee that is currently an eye sore and structurally questionable will be rebuilt to match the stone on 18 bridge. We are wrapping up the details as we speak and are scheduling with contractors to get on their schedule sooner than later. The second approved project is improved security doors on the pool bar. These improved doors will be automatic and will not require two men and a truck to move every morning and every evening.

Another bright note is the excellent work by all of our Members recruiting new Members. We had 11 new applications just under the deadline of the Initiation Fee Increase. This puts us on a waiting list status going into the golf season. That is ahead of budget and shows the excitement of our Membership and potential Members from the metro area. We are in a position to attract new Members and consider raising our

initiation fees, to match the strong demand for our Club. I ask all of you to continue to promote and recruit Members that would be a good fit with our incredible Membership.

And this brings me to our Master Plan. As I mentioned last month, we are well under way with planning and reserving material for our project later this fall. I want to make sure that we all understand the disruption that we will experience. This is a 12 week project that will begin around August 15th. The project as planned is a hole by hole renovation, all the while trying to minimize disruption to our Membership. We will be able to have temporary greens on most holes to keep our course open and playable. Winter golfers are used to this practice and those of us that require warmer weather to play can quickly adjust. To reiterate, our course WILL NOT BE CLOSED at any time late this summer or fall. It will be fun to come out and see the progress and the course take shape over this relatively short period of time.

The 18 tee project is a great example of good planning and proper project management. The project was on time and under budget. The result is a beautiful finishing hole that matches our golf course, Clubhouse, and the quality of our Membership. Thanks to the leadership of the last several Board of Directors that made this a reality.

As our friend Tommy Gysin says "It is never too early to schedule your Scotch Match." See you around the Club!

Lakewood's guest restriction policy is in effect as of May 1st.

A Member may invite only one guest between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and

Holiday restrictions are the same as Sundays. The Member must play with his/her guest.

Once again for 2017 – A Member may bring up to 11 guests (a total of three foursomes) on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday afternoons after 1:45 p.m. This will accommodate your business/personal groups with only one Member required to play with the group. As always, the Member is responsible for his guests and pace of play. If your group is planning any food/beverage service, you may make your reservations farther in advance.

Course & Club Safety Issues

There are several areas where safety and
course care are an issue on the Course.

- 1) Please wait for players to leave the
cart parking areas on holes #2 and #9.
 - 2) Do not drive your cart up to #12 tee
box via the cart path on #6.
 - 3) Do not hit range balls over the fence.
 - 4) Carts should not be within 50 feet of tees and
greens.
 - 5) The sand/seed mix in your
carts may be used for fairways and tee
boxes.
- Please be considerate of your
fellow Members and help maintain the
great condition of your course. Also as
a reminder, please drive slowly when
entering the Club. We now have a lot
of activity so be cautious when driving!

Golf Course Protocol

When on the golf course, please
remember that **the playing priority of
several holes is determined by the
higher number hole playing first.**

For example, if two groups arrive at #14
and #1 at the same time, players on #14
have teeing priority before players on
#1. The same applies with holes #6 and
#12- please wait for #12 Blue Tee to clear
before teeing off #6. Another area this
occurs is #15 and #17; #17 players have
the right of way.

Organization. Tee times immediately
following the block of eight (8) Ladies'
times are available based on classification
guidelines. As Team Play has priority on
Thursdays that have either "A" or "B"
Team play, the number of times necessary
for Team will be included in the eight tee
time total.

2017 jr golf information

Minimum Age for the Junior Golf Development Program is seven (7) years old.

The Fee is \$180 for each junior golfer.

The Lakewood Country Club Junior Golf Program has multiple goals: Safety, Fun, Camaraderie, Skill Development, and learning to "Play" the game to name a few. This program is designed as a broad overview of the game, as well as the opportunity to receive PGA Professional instruction in a group environment.

In addition to our Junior Golf Development Program, we are offering for an additional fee, **Accelerated Learning Clinics** that will provide each student the opportunity for much more individualized instruction. These clinics will cap at a maximum of five (5) students for five (5) lessons and are completely customizable to meet the needs of the parents and students. The fee for this program is: 1-2 students in class - \$175 per student, 3-5 students in class - \$125 per student.

We also offer individual lessons from our PGA Professional Staff. These can be scheduled anytime throughout the season. If you prefer your student to get the maximum individual instruction, these lessons are designed for that purpose. Flexibility is maximized as lessons are scheduled according to the schedule of the parent and instructor. Fees for these lessons are determined between parent and instructor.

Every Wednesday morning the junior golfers will play golf on the course. This is partnered with a skills development clinic. The skills training will center on time-tested fundamentals and special attention will be given to woods/irons development for full swing as well as short-game training for putting, chipping, pitching, and bunkers. Additional attention will be given to learning the basic rules of golf, as well as, proper golf course etiquette so that the junior golfers are able to conduct themselves as young ladies and gentlemen.

Dress Code: Same as adults, collared shirts are required and traditional walking shorts must be of mid-thigh length. **No denim material or cargo shorts/pants are permitted.** Golf shoes or flat-soled tennis shoes are acceptable footwear. **Please**




